












RP DOMAIN 2: Distribution of Initiatives

Number of initiatives & type




Most funded priorities




RP DOMAIN 2: Ratio of Initiatives

Ratio of projects and policies




Ratio of national and regional policies




RP DOMAIN 2: Distribution of Initiatives

Distribution of policies across domains





Distribution of projects across domains
